
Wood posts won't last; they split and rot. Vinyl posts are thin and have the unnatural temperance of plastic. With Trex, you get the best of both worlds.

The beefy 5" post gives the fence a more substantial look while the post color adds a beautiful contrast to the metal material.

On a more practical note, Trex posts are excellent alternatives to metal and wood simply because they won't rust or rot. Consider upgrading from a wood fence post to Trex. While your wood fence will degrade over time, with Trex posts, repair and replacement will be limited to just your rails and pickets. These are less expensive lumber components than posts, and they are less challenging to replace.
