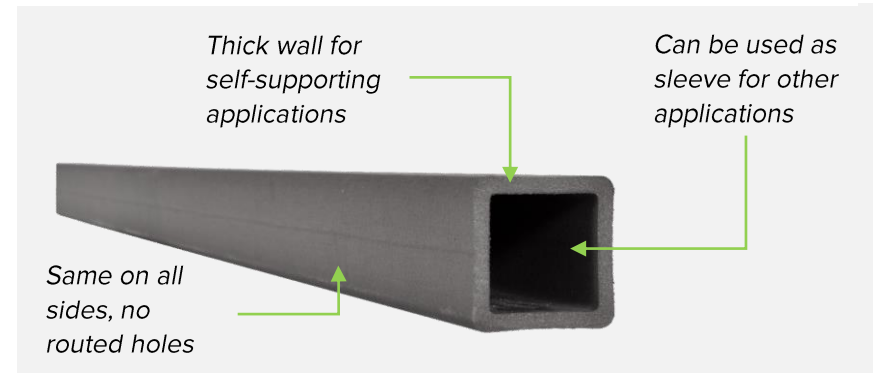

# TREX COMPOSITE FENCE POSTS, NOT JUST FOR TREX FENCING

Ornamental fence panels, such as steel, wrought iron or aluminum, look particularly striking when combined with Trex. The stately 5" post gives the fence a more substantial look while the post color adds a beautiful contrast to the ornamental metal.



Integrate Trex fence posts with ornamental panels for a corrosion-free, sturdy, colorful alternative. Attach virtually any panel to Trex posts with third-party flat mount brackets and exterior screws.



From a practical frame of reference, Trex posts are excellent alternatives to wood simply because they won't rot. Consider upgrading from a **wood fence post** to Trex. While a wood fence will degrade over time, using Trex posts instead means repair and replacement will be limited to just the wooden rails and pickets. This isn't just less costly. It will also save the back breaking work of digging up and installing new posts.



... and consider other applications. Trex fence posts can be used for community signposts (like this example), sleeves for structural posts (such as decks, awnings, privacy screens), rafters for shade structures, and more!
